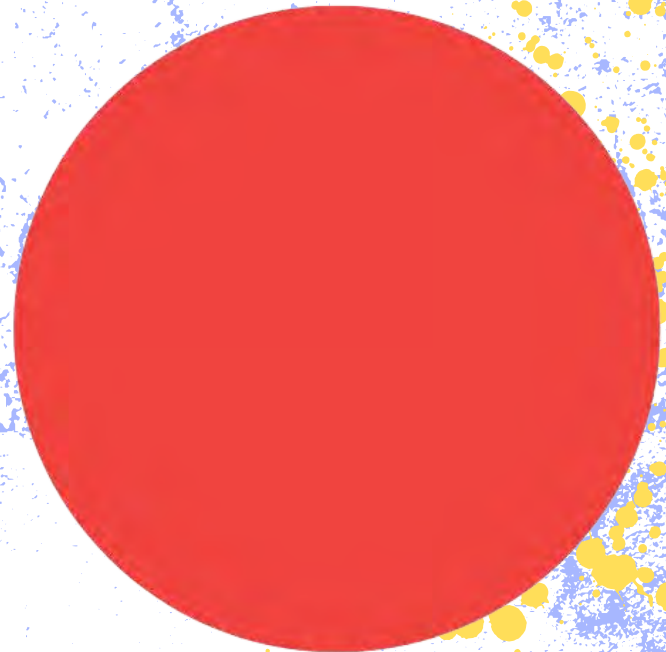

BEMO MYERS, DIRECTOR



Bemo Myers has been directing New G for over 20 years. His father Byron Myers, Sr. started the group in 1970, so Bemo has been involved for 53 years, since he was eight years old or so.

Bemo was named one of St. Joseph's Top 20 Most Influential People, has received the Shining Star Award for Volunteer Work In Community from the Youth Alliance of St. Joseph, and two Ruby Awards -- for Best Actor and Best Musical Director! For his day job, Bemo is the CEO/President of Specialty Industries in St. Joseph. Bemo is married to Carol, his wife of 35 years this June.

Carol is Director and Assistant Program Director for the local community theater, Robidoux Resident Theater. Bemo and Carol have two kids, Mia and Joey, both of whom were in the group as kids and are very active in the arts as adults.

HOW IT ALL BEGAN

The year New G started, Byron Myers (right) was putting together a Christmas Cantata. The students asked Byron the famous question, "Why can't we keep doing this? Why do we only do fun stuff like this at Christmas?" Byron, in all his wisdom said, "I don't know." and New G was born. And Phyllis, in all her wisdom, did the books, and a lot of behind the scenes work.



New G was started by Byron and Phyllis Myers, in 1970. We began at Wyatt Park Christian Church. Even then, New G was an inter-denominational youth choir. That has not changed. The very first tour New G ever went on was one week to Texas, and they rented charter busses, wrote dialogues, just like we do today.



New G has lost people through the years, but never while they were an active part of the group, until recently. Phyllis Myers passed away last year, Byron passed in 2021, and Scott Johnson (left), another very important sponsor, passed away in 2020. We are so grateful for the time all those we have lost have dedicated to New G.

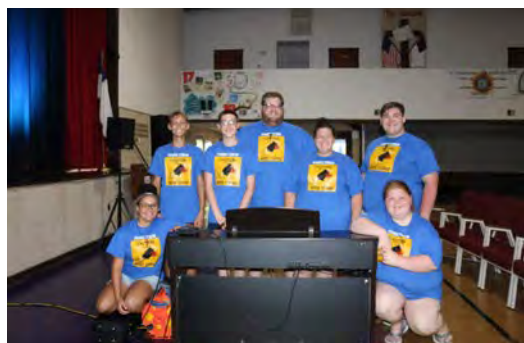


WORK CREWS

While on tour in California, in 1972, a man named Henry Butcher gave every singer a cross. He had carved each one by hand. He ended up distributing these crosses all over the world. After he passed away, his church continued making the crosses. No count was ever made as to how many were passed out, but we guess it would be well into the thousands.

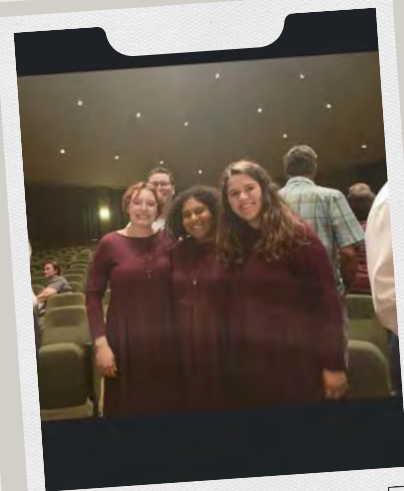
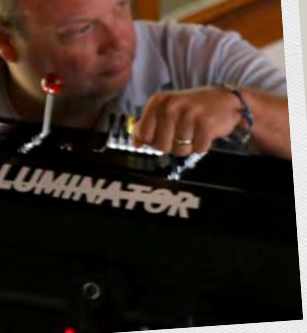

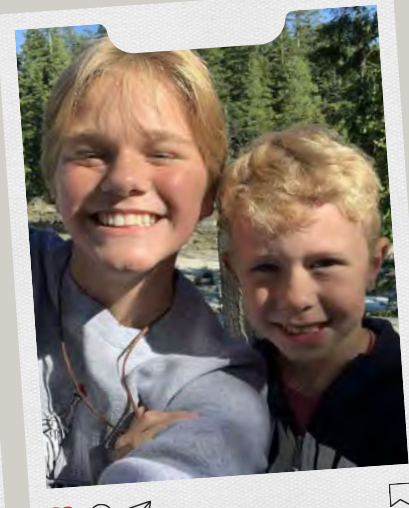
