



To Our Host Church — What to Expect

We are incredibly grateful for your willingness to host The New Generation Singers. Saying “yes” to a performance is more than scheduling an event—it is partnering with us in ministry as we share God’s message through word and song.

To help make this experience smooth and enjoyable, we’ve outlined what you can expect and how you can best prepare for our time together.

Phase 1: Arrival & Setup

We typically plan to arrive around **5:00 PM**, though this can sometimes be as early as **3:00 PM** depending on our travel schedule.

On the **day of your performance**, our Executive Director, **Byron Myers**, will be in contact with you to help coordinate timing, answer questions, and ensure everything runs smoothly.

Upon Arrival

We will first connect with a designated church representative to:

- Discuss what can and cannot be moved in the performance space (stage, altar, etc.)
- Ensure we are honoring and respecting your facility
- Identify power access and any important electrical considerations (outlets, circuits, breaker access if needed)

Many churches have concerns about technical requirements. Please know that we travel with a full, experienced tech team and all the equipment needed to perform.

Our goal is simply to partner with someone who knows your space so we can set up efficiently and respectfully.

Space Needs

To prepare for the performance, we will need:

- One large room for **female singers to change**
 - One large room for **male singers to change**
 - Two additional rooms for **adult chaperones** (Male & Female)
 - A **secure or lockable room** for purses and important personal belongings
