To help make this experience smooth and enjoyable, we’ve outlined what you can expect and how you can best prepare for our time together.

Phase 3: The Performance

We are flexible and want to serve your church well.

- Typical start time: **7:00–7:30 PM**
- Length: **60–90 minutes**

Flexible Scheduling

We are absolutely open to:

- **Earlier performance times** (which simply shift our full schedule earlier)
- Adjusting our arrival time to match your needs
- Coordinating in advance so our travel schedule supports your church’s timeline

If part of a Sunday morning worship service:

- We typically see this best served as a Sermon in Song Opportunity
 - The Sermon in Song includes five songs woven together with singer-written dialogues to make a “sermon” and is around 30 minutes long.
 - We can be flexible to the church’s and Pastor’s needs as to placement in the service.
- We are happy to assist with service music or worship elements if needed

Offering

While we do **not require an offering**, many churches choose to receive a **love offering**, which helps:

- Maintain the group and its equipment
- Help offset travel costs that the singers do not raise or pay for
- Provide scholarships for future singers
- Alongside fundraising and singers’ tour payments, offerings are a key source of support for the group.
- All adult sponsors are 100% volunteer and serve all year long
